Corporations and organisations in Hong Kong that offer goods or services to individuals in the EU, or monitor the behaviour of individuals in the EU should be aware that they are likely going to be subject to the requirements of the GDPR.

In order to help organisations understand the GDPR’s standards and the possible impact on their operations, the Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data, Hong Kong (“PCPD”) will organise or co-organise with third parties activities in relation to the education and promotion on the EU GDPR.
