Artificial Intelligence











The Guidance on the Ethical Development and Use of Artificial Intelligence is intended for organisations which develop artificial intelligence (AI) or use AI in their operations. The objectives of the Guidance are to facilitate the healthy development and use of AI in Hong Kong and assist organisations in complying with the provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486) in their development and use of AI. This pamphlet highlights the core recommendations of the Guidance.











TETHICAL PRINCIPLES FOR AI

ACCOUNTABILITY

Organisations should be responsible for what they do and should provide sound justifications for their actions

TRANSPARENCY AND INTERPRETABILITY

Organisations should disclose their use of AI and the relevant policies to stakeholders while striving to improve the interpretability of automated and AI-assisted decisions

FAIRNESS

Unjust bias and unlawful discrimination should be avoided in the use of Al

RELIABILITY, ROBUSTNESS AND SECURITY

Al systems should operate reliably, should be resilient to errors and protected against attacks



HUMAN OVERSIGHT

The level of human involvement in the operation of AI should be proportionate to the risks and impact of using AI

DATA PRIVACY

Effective data governance should be put in place to protect individuals' personal data privacy in the development and use of Al

BENEFICIAL AI

The use of AI should provide benefits and minimise harm to stakeholders



4 Major Business Processes for Ethical Development and Use of Al





Establish

Al Strategy and Governance

- Provide directions from the top
- Al Governance Committee to oversee the development and use of Al
- Staff training and awareness raising



Conduct

Risk Assessment and Human Oversight

- Comprehensive and early risk assessment, consider:
 - ▶ What is the potential impact of AI on stakeholders?
 - How significant is the impact if it occurs?
 - ▶ How likely will the impact occurs?
- Take a risk-based approach to adopting appropriate risk mitigation measures
- Determine appropriate level of human oversight



Human-in-the-loop

Human actors retain control in the decision-making process to prevent any errors by Al

Human-in-command

Human actors oversee the operation of AI and intervene whenever necessary

Human-out-of-the-loop

Al makes decisions without human intervention

Development of Al Models and Management of Al Systems

- Ensuring quality and lawful use of data for training Al models
- Testing AI models to ensure reliability, robustness and fairness
- Ongoing monitoring and review of Al systems

Communication and Engagement with Stakeholders

- Being transparent with stakeholders
- Channels for engagement with stakeholders
- Comprehensible communications using layman's language


